Minutes of an Extraordinary Meeting of Ufford Parish Council held in the Village Hall, Ufford on Thursday 31st August 2017 at 7.30pm.

DRAFT MINUTES FOR APPROVAL AT NEXT MEETING.

1. In attendance - *Chairman Keith Lievesley (KL), Councillors David Chadwick (DC), Frieda Gosling (FG) and Graham Bowes (GB) plus 5 members of the public.*

3. Declarations of Interest and Dispensations. *None.*

4. Members of the public are invited to address the council with regard to any Agenda item.
No comments were initially made.

5. Planning.
 - a. 17/00564/FUL Sherwood, Marholm Road – Planning re-consultation.

There was lengthy discussion on this matter, during which time the chairman temporarily suspended the meeting in order to hear further representation from the applicants. Councillors felt that this third iteration of the plans still failed to meet requirements relating to the scale of the

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building which were previously set in pre-planning guidance from the planning department case officer and subsequently in a post-application report by the conservation officer.

Councillors were also of the opinion that changes of personnel at the city council coupled with contradictory statements from the case officer had resulted in a complete reversal of the planning department's stance with regard to the size and scale of the proposed building. On the grounds that it was pointless to continue to seek compliance with criteria that the planning department had themselves apparently now abandoned, councillors voted not to oppose the application.

b. 17/00696/HHFUL Highlands – Demolition of existing conservatory to the rear, two storey side and rear extensions and single storey side extension.

Written communication received from Mike Roberts of Peterborough City Council indicated that the planning office is aware that elements currently under construction at the rear of the property are apparently at variance with the approved plans. Parish Councillors decided that this awareness meant that their own further involvement at this stage was not necessary (nor indeed possible given that they have no way of monitoring this work in progress).
