 - a. *19/00865/CTR Wind Rush, 3 Walcot Road – Tree works to include willow fell, works to Cedar. Permitted.*
 - b. *19/00949/CTR, The Coach House, 5 Fountain Court – Tree works to include fell sweet chestnut, and replace, fell magnolia tree and replace with wisteria and thinning of conifers. Permitted.*
 - c. *19/00734/HHFUL, Thorne, Newport Way – Render existing front elevation and alter dormer window. Proposed single storey extension to rear. Permitted.*
 - d. *19/01111/CTR, Annagh House, Main Street – Eucalyptus reduction. No objection.*
 - e. *19/01113/CTR, Hightrees, 2 Walcot Road – Beech crown reduction. Comments were agreed for submission.*
 - f. *19/00969/HHFUL & 19/00970/LBC, Ufford Hall – Minor demolition to part of existing boundary wall and addition of double gates (part retrospective). Comments were agreed for submission.*
 - g. *19/00992/HHFUL, 12 Newport Way – Demolition of existing rear projection and construction of two storey and single storey rear extension. No objection.*
